### **Early Payment Discounts:**

A discount of **5%** is given when full payment of the **annual fees** is made on or before the first day of the academic year

### **Notice of Withdrawal:**

Every notice of intention to withdraw a child from the School, for any reason, must be in writing to the Director of Academics and sent **at the latest before the opening of the term at the end of which the child is to leave.** If late or no notice of withdrawal is given full payment of next term's School Fees will be required.

A Caution deposit of \$500 will be required if the Annual Fee option is selected. A Caution deposit of one term's fee will be required if Termly Fee option is selected

The caution deposit (or balance remaining therein) will be offset against the school fees of the last term in school, provided that correct notice of withdrawal of one full term is given prior to withdrawal or if the child is in the final semester of the entire course of study.

This caution deposit is non-refundable if the place is not taken up.

\* Annual Insurance Fee includes emergency medical treatment to your child while in school. It includes transporting your child to his/her residence in the event of illness or injury. Does not include hospitalization.

\* External/international examinations of iSecondary (Year 9), IGCSE (Year 11) and IAL (Year 12/13) are not included in this fee structure
